



# **- YOUNG ENTREPRENEURS EDUCATION AWARD CONTEST - 2020**

## **— Official Rules —**

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN.

A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING.

VOID WHERE PROHIBITED.

### **Who May Enter (Eligibility)**

The Young Entrepreneurs Education Award Contest - 2020 (the "Contest") is open to legal residents of the 50 United States and the District of Columbia ("U.S."), and Canada (excluding residents of Quebec), who have been enrolled as an Origami Owl, LLC ("O2") "Young Entrepreneurs" (also referred to as 'Owlettes' or 'Bros') (hereinafter "Young Entrepreneur" or "Entrant") in O2's Young Entrepreneurs Program for at least one (1) year at the start of the Contest Period. Such Young Entrepreneurs must: (1) be a senior in high school and have not have attended college at the start of the Contest Period; (2) be a "Graduating Young Entrepreneur" (a Young Entrepreneur who has graduated from high school by the start of the 2020 O2 Experience Convention occurring in July 2020); and (3) be in good standing (as determined by O2 in its sole discretion). Entry into this Contest constitutes Entrant's full and unconditional agreement to these Official Rules and O2's decisions and interpretations, which are final and binding in all matters related to the Contest. A parent or guardian of a Young Entrepreneur who is a minor must provide an Affidavit of Consent on behalf of the minor to be eligible to participate in the Contest and for minor's acceptance of the official Contest rules.

### **Contest Period**

The Contest will begin at 12:00 noon CT on January 1, 2020 and will end on 11:59 p.m. CT on March 31, 2020 ("Contest Period"). Entries must be received by 11:59 p.m. CT on March 31, 2020. All dates are subject to change.

### **Overview:**

Young Entrepreneurs may enter the Contest by creating and submitting an essay ("Entry") via email to [Owlettes@origamiowl.com](mailto:Owlettes@origamiowl.com) describing why they should be a recipient of a Young Entrepreneurs Education Award and specifying what the Award will be used towards in connection with education expenses. Entries must also include the following: (i) the dates the Entrant has been enrolled in O2's Young Entrepreneurs Program; (ii) a description of what the Entrant has learned from O2's Young Entrepreneurs Program (both professionally and personally); (iii) a

description of how the Entrant has incorporated O2's Mission Statement into their lives; and (iv) a photograph of Entrant showcasing Entrant's involvement with O2's Young Entrepreneurs Program. An Entrant may also submit a video as a part of the Entry (video submission is optional). The Entries will be reviewed and voted on by an Independent Award Committee and the top two (2) Entries receiving the most votes will be selected as the winners ("Winners"). Each Winner will receive a prize consisting of a cash 'education award' in the amount of \$2,000 to be used toward education expenses.

## **How to Enter:**

To enter the Contest, Young Entrepreneurs must submit their Entry via email during Contest Period to [Owlettes@origamiowl.com](mailto:Owlettes@origamiowl.com). By submitting Entry, Young Entrepreneur's parent or guardian provides irrevocable authorization for O2 to use and publish the Entrant's name, business, photograph and/or video recording, personal story, state of residence and/or likeness in connection with Contest. Entries may only be submitted via email. O2 is not responsible for late, incomplete, illegible or incorrectly submitted Entries. O2 has no obligation to advise Entrant of an incomplete Entry. Limit of one entry per Young Entrepreneur. Once the Entry is sent via email, the Entry is considered final and may not be modified, supplemented or edited.

## **Judging / Voting / Selection of Finalists and Winners:**

On or about April 1, 2020 through June 15, 2020 (the "Voting Period"), a panel of Judges via an Independent Award Committee ("Committee") will, in its sole discretion, select the top two (2) Entries as Winners ("Winners") from all eligible Entries received during the Contest Period based on the following criteria ("Judging Criteria"): (1) Content (33%); (2) Overall Impact (33%); and (3) Demonstration of Commitment to O2's Mission Statement (33%).

- Content – How the Entrant puts ideas together so the Judge may understand the Entry; genuineness and authenticity
- Overall Impact – The sense one gets upon reading an Entry for the first time. Compelling Entries evoke laughter, sadness, anger, pride, wonder or another intense emotion. The initial impact should evoke a sense of what participating in O2's Young Entrepreneurs Program involves including learned business skills.
- Demonstration of Commitment to O2's Mission Statement – How the Entrant commits to being a Force for Good; to Love, Inspire, & Motivate people to reach their Dreams & Empower them to make a difference in the lives of others.

The two (2) Entries with the highest number of votes at the end of the last day of the Voting Period will be deemed the Winners. The names of the Winners will be announced at the annual 2020 O2 Experience Convention. The Winners will also be notified as follows: (1) O2 will post the names of the Winners on O2's Facebook page; (2) Winners will be notified via telephone by one of O2's Founders; and (3) Winners will receive a follow-up email after telephone call by one of O2's Founders. Winners must be affiliated with an O2 Independent Designer in good standing (as determined by O2 in its sole discretion) at the time the Winners are announced.

In the event of a tie in number of votes on eligible Entries, the Winner will be chosen in the Committee's sole discretion. Any ties will be resolved by the date the annual 2020 O2 Experience Convention occurs.

## **Prize(s):**

There will be two (2) Winners chosen. The Prize will be awarded to the Winner's parent or guardian on behalf of minor. The Winners will each receive a "Prize" consisting of a cash 'education award' in the amount of \$2,000. Decisions of O2 are final and binding. Winner's parent or legal guardian will have until August 31, 2020 to claim or disclaim the Prize. If Winner's parent or legal guardian declines the Prize, Winner's winning status is then voluntarily voided. O2 will make all reasonable attempts to notify Winner; however, if no contact is made after such attempts, O2 reserves the right to award the Prize to the next qualifying Winner.

## **Taxes:**

AWARDS OF PRIZE(S) TO POTENTIAL WINNER(S) ARE SUBJECT TO THE EXPRESS REQUIREMENT THAT THEY SUBMIT TO O2 ALL DOCUMENTATION REQUESTED BY O2 TO PERMIT IT TO COMPLY WITH ALL APPLICABLE STATE, FEDERAL AND LOCAL TAX REPORTING. TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, ALL TAXES IMPOSED ON PRIZE(S) WILL BE PAID BY O2. In order to receive a Prize, potential Winner must submit tax documentation requested by O2 or otherwise required by applicable law, to O2 or a representative for O2 or the relevant tax authority, as determined by applicable law. The potential winner is responsible for ensuring that they comply with all applicable tax laws and filing requirements. If a potential winner fails to provide such documentation or comply with such laws, the Prize may be forfeited and O2 may, in its sole discretion, select an alternate potential Winner from the Finalists.

## **General Prize Conditions:**

Prizes are non-transferrable. No substitutions. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. Any portion of the Prize that is not used is forfeited. If O2 is unable to contact any potential Winner or if a potential Winner (or parent / guardian) fails to return all requested forms, fully-executed by the specified date, or fails to comply with these Official Rules, her or his prize will be forfeited at O2's discretion.

As a condition of being awarded Prize, Winners, and, to the extent the Winner is a minor then their parent or legal guardian will be required to execute and deliver to O2 a signed Affidavit of Eligibility / Release of Liability and a Right of Publicity Statement within five (5) days of the notification date before any Prize is awarded.

## **Odds of Winning:**

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible Entries received during the Contest Period.

## **Consent and Release:**

By entering into the Contest, each entrant acknowledges that irrevocable authorization has been received from the Entrant (or Entrant's parent or legal guardian) for O2 to use and publish the

Entrant's name, business, photograph and/or video recording, personal story, state of residence and/or likeness in connection with Contest.
